FOREST FESTIVAL OF THE ARTS OKAYAMA

The international art festival "Forest Art Festival: Sunny Country Okayama" will be held in the northern region of Okayama Prefecture.

The "Forest Art Festival: Sunny Country Okayama" is a project that spans 12 cities and towns: Tsuyama City, Takahashi City, Niimi City, Maniwa City, Mimasaka City, Shinjō Village, Kagamino Town, Shōō Town, Nagi Town, Nishiwakura Village, Kumenan Town, and Misaki Town.

This area extends from the Chūgoku Mountains, which divide the Sanyo and Sanin regions, to the Kibi Highlands, and lies in the upstream regions of the three major rivers sourced from the Chūgoku Mountains (the Yoshii River, Asahi River, and Takahashi River). The region boasts lush, majestic nature, historical post towns and castle towns along the old highways, and scenic towns that flourished as river transport hubs. Additionally, it is home to the three renowned hot springs of Mimasaka (Yunogō Onsen, Okutsu Onsen, and Yubara Onsen), with high quality spring waters. The area has a landscape and regional resources that are distinct from the southern coastal areas along the Seto Inland Sea.

By showcasing artworks that highlight the region's appeal from a new perspective and offering extraordinary, unique experiences, the festival aims to promote tourism through art-based itineraries, increase interaction among visitors, and foster civic pride.

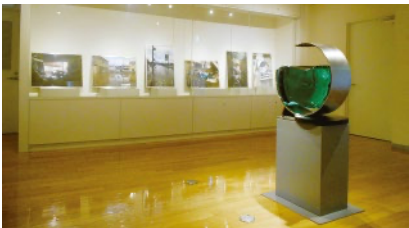

In line with the Forest Art Festival, the Yamada Bee Farm Gallery will be open for a limited time. The gallery will display approximately 400 points rare paintings, focusing on the works of the Barbizon school of 19th-century French painters such as Millet, Corot, and Rousseau, along with Realists like Courbet, Impressionists like Monet and Renoir, and modern French masters like Buffet. The exhibition is by reservation only, with a maximum of 60 people per session. Each session lasts two hours, with timed entry and an admission fee.

We are exhibiting the sculptural works of Mr. Tsukasa Nakahara, a glass artist originally from Tsuyama City. His pieces are crafted using a technique that involves bonding and polishing flat glass. During the 2018 Western Japan floods, his studio in Mabicho, Kurashiki City was damaged. He has repaired artworks that were nearly completed but damaged during the disaster and now presents them at this exhibition.

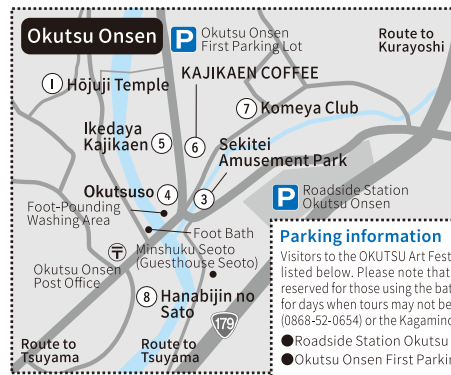
6th OKUTSU Art Festival

September 14 (Sat) – December 1 (Sun)

Experience art in the peaceful village of Kagamino Town, Okutsu, known for its clear streams and hot springs.

The Okutsu Art Festival aims to transform the area along Route 179, which runs from the Innosho Interchange on the Chugoku Expressway to Kurayoshi City (where the Tottori Prefectural Museum of Art is planned to be built), into a "local art" zone, offering an experience that cannot be found on any motorway.

During the OKUTSU Art Festival, all facilities in the Okutsu area, including unused buildings, will be used as art hubs over a two-year period, presenting new possibilities for the relationship between the region and art. Furthermore, promising young artists from northern Okayama, who are studying at universities outside the prefecture, will be invited to participate in an artist-in-residence programme, where they will stay and complete their works. Through this initiative, we aim to cultivate art and culture in the Okutsu, Kagamino, and Mimasaka regions, promoting local growth and revitalisation.

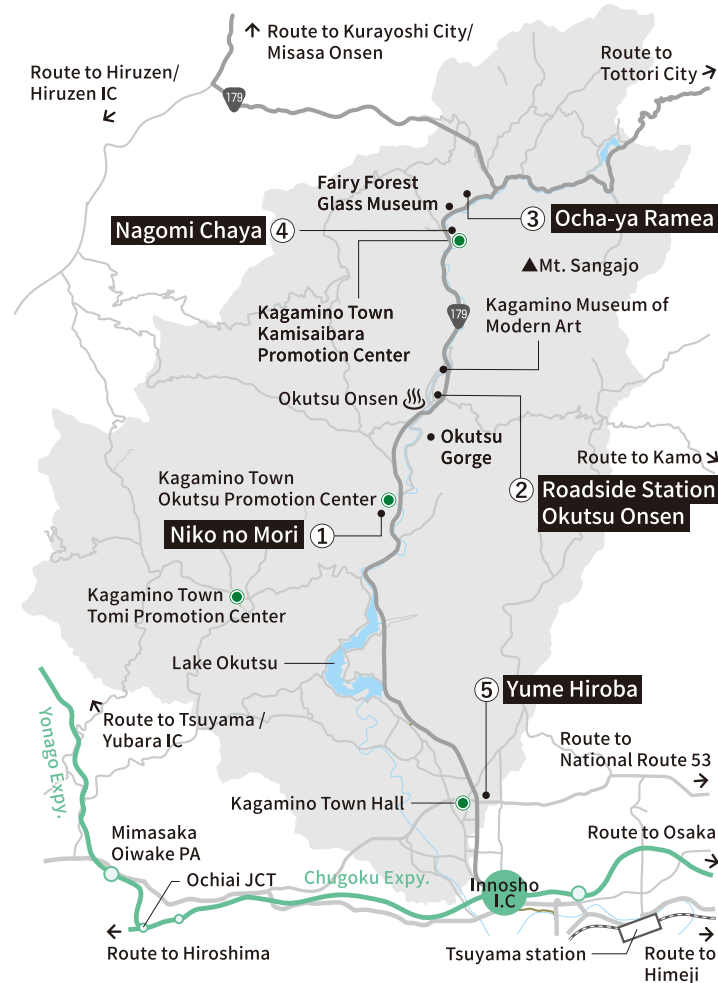
